Recent Overhead Transmission Line Technology and Environmental Measures

CIGRE International Colloquium Sendai, Miyagi, Japan, 3-7 October 2023

Colloquium Theme

Sendai Colloquium is organized under the general theme of "Recent Overhead Transmission Line Technologies and Environmental Measures" and is based on the preferential subjects of "Sustainable OHL (Overhead Lines), Environment and Planning", "Reliability of OHL, Advanced Construction and Maintenance", "Resilience of OHL. Recent Technologies for Disaster Recovery", from SCB2 (Overhead Lines), SCC3 (Power System Environmental Performance), SCC4 (Power System Technical Performance). Over the three days, many papers will be presented in two tutorials and seven sessions. Social programs including receptions, technical tours, and companion tours are also planned to contribute to international exchange.

Although the end of the COVID-19 is not in sight at this writing, we will proceed with preparations based on holding the conference on-site, and through the CIGRE 2023 Sendai Colloquium, we hope to develop opportunities to deepen information exchange and academic exchange with everyone concerned and to contribute to the development of power technology around the world.

Venue

Sendai is a city in Japan located in the central part of Miyagi Prefecture, approximately 300 km northnortheast of Tokyo. With a population of about 1.09 million, it is the largest city in the Tohoku region of Japan in terms of population and economic scale. The venue of the Colloquium is Sendai International Center which is located about 5 minutes by subway from Sendai Station and 90 minutes by Tohoku Shinkansen bullet train from Tokyo.

✓ DLR (Dynamic Line Rating), upgrading/uprating, minimizing deforestation, DC transmission, environmental assessment, carbon neutrality, social acceptance, EMF (ElectroMagnetic Field), biodiversity, SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals), eco-designs, risk communication, asset management, renewable energy

PS2: Reliability of OHL, Advanced Construction and Maintenance (joint PS with C4)

 ✓ monitoring, life extension measures, drones, robotics, digitalization (AI, IoT, utilization of data, etc.), maintenance management (corridor management), lightning overvoltage, insulation coordination, power quality, EMC (ElectroMagnetic Compatibility), systematic analysis

PS3: Resilience of OHL, Recent Technologies for Disaster Recovery

However, there is a possibility that the colloquium may be held "in person and online" or "online only", depending on the circumstances.
